We are happy to announce that the Mycobacteriology Laboratory at National Jewish Health Advanced Diagnostic Laboratories has continued to align its interpretations of susceptibility tests to the Clinical and Laboratory Standards Institute (CLSI) for nontuberculous mycobacteria and aerobic actinomycetes. The minimum inhibitory concentrations and CLSI interpretive breakpoints for all slowly growing nontuberculous mycobacteria (refer to CLSI documents M24 and M62 for a list of organisms) will go into effect on May 17, 2021.
